TIME OF THANKSGIVING Of the original motifs, the celebration of the fertility of the flocks and of the budding barley, from the grateful hearts of those early shepherds and farmers, as few among many other communwell as that of the paschal lamb of the Passover itself, only the last named motif has survived. Deliverance and freedom form the central theme of Passover, with gratitude and increased faith as its cause and its effect. The Christian friends might refresh their memories by reading chapters 12 to 14 of the Book of Exodus, common to both faiths.

THE SEDER The Seder (pronounced sayder) is the observance in the private homes, consisting of instruction about the institution, songs and prayers, and the eating of unleavened bread. (Compare Luke 22,7 Acts 12:3; 20:3).


