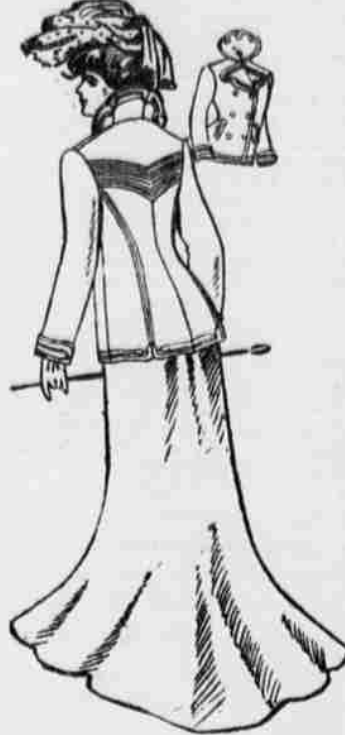

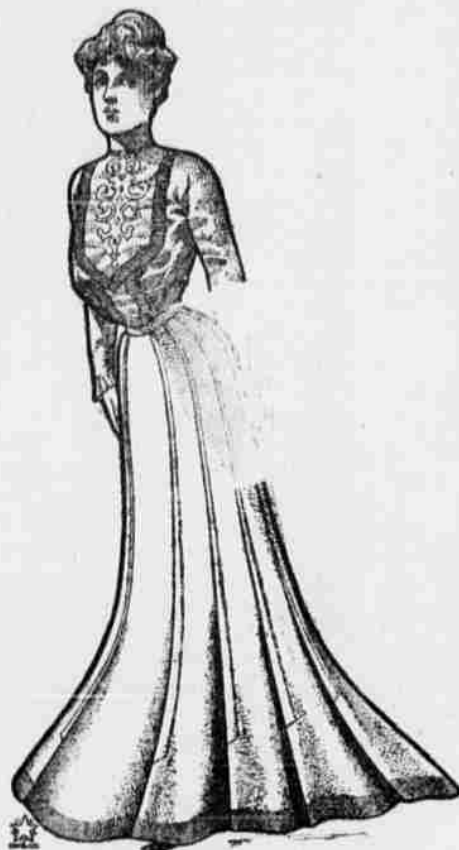

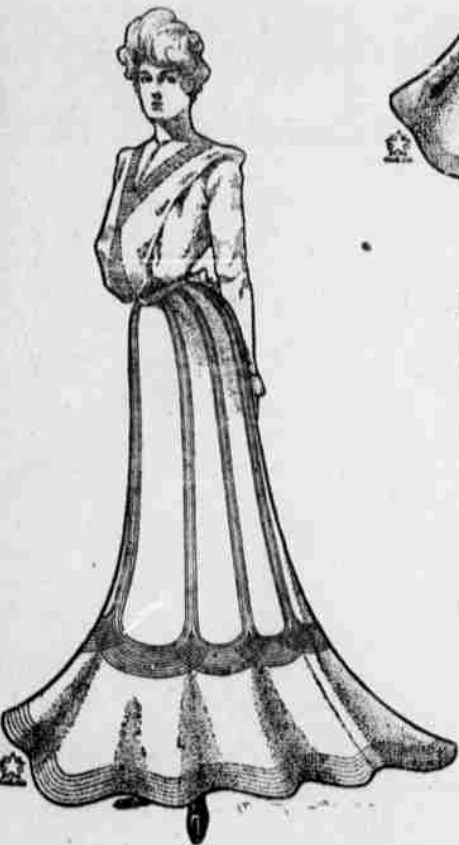
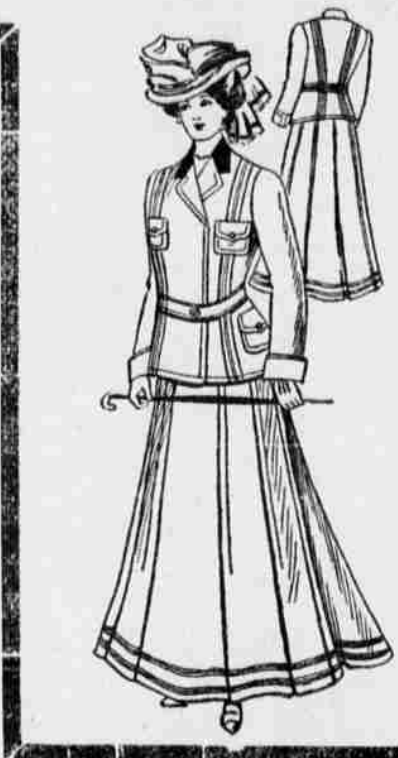
Correct Skirt Models for Fall and Winter

PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT.

The following Proposed Amendment to the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, as hereinafter set forth, in full, is submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska, to be voted upon at the general election to be held Tuesday, November 4, A. D. 1902.

A Joint Resolution proposing to amend section one of Article fifteen, of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, relative to the manner of electing and appointing amendments to the Constitution of the State of Nebraska.

BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. That section one of Article fifteen of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Either branch of the legislature may propose amendments to this Constitution, and if the same be agreed to by three-fifths of the members elected to each house, such proposed amendments shall be entered on the Journals, with the yeas and nays, and published at least once each week in at least one newspaper in each county where a newspaper is published, for thirty days immediately preceding the next election of senators and representatives, at which election the same shall be submitted to the electors for approval or rejection, and if a majority of the electors voting at such election shall be in favor of the amendment, the same shall become a part of this Constitution. When more than one amendment is submitted at the same election, they shall be so submitted as to enable the electors to vote on each amendment separately.

All ballots used at such election on such amendment or amendments shall have written or printed thereon the following: For proposed amendment to the Constitution relating to (here insert the subject of the amendment) and the vote of each elector voting on such amendment or amendments shall be designated by the elector by making a cross with a pen or pencil in a circle or square to be placed on the right of the lines the words "For or Against" the proposed amendments as he shall desire to vote thereon or by indicating his preference on a voting machine when such machine is in use.

I, Geo. W. Marsh, secretary of state of the State of Nebraska, do hereby certify that the foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Nebraska is a true and correct copy of the original enrolled and engrossed bill as passed by the Twenty-seventh session of the legislature of the State of Nebraska, as appears from said original bill on file in this office, and that said proposed amendment is submitted to the qualified voters of the State of Nebraska for their adoption or rejection at the general election to be held on Tuesday the 4th day of November, A. D. 1902.

In testis whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and signed the great seal of the state of Nebraska.

Done at Lincoln this 22nd day of July in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two, of the Independence of the United States the One Hundred and Twenty-seventh, and of this state the Thirty-sixth.
