In the case of the state against
Wm. Krenz, which was pending
last week as we went to press,
was decided against the defend-
ant by the jury, after being out
about twenty hours. The court
sentenced him to the penitentiary
for two years. His attorneys
have appealed the case to the
supreme court and applied to
that court for a bail bond for his
release while the case is being
reviewed. The court fixed the
bond at \$1,500 which has been
signed and approved, his father
going on the bond. Joe Krenz,
who demanded a separate trial
gave bond for his appearance on
the first day of the nest term of
court.
The divorce case of Judkins
vs. Judkins was tried Friday.
Several witnesses for both sides
were heard. The court refused
to grant either a divorce.
In the Christie divorce case
the judge allowed $\$ 100$, tempor-
ary alimony and the case con-
tinued until next term of court.
In the road case of Robert
Stone of Comstock, the court
held the requirements of the law
had not been complied with in
the proceedings to establish the
road and granted an injunction
against the overseer opening the
road.
