BOARD OF EQUALIZATION.

Broken Bow, August 10, 1909. Board met as per adjournment on July 14th with all members present.

Minutes of July 14th read and approved. Request of Nelson Brock for school judgment levy against school district No. 177 was read, and upon motion the request was rejected.

The balance of the day was spent in committee work and at 6 p m, the board adjourned till August 24, 1909.

August 14th, 1909. Board met at 8:30 a m, with all members present except Grint and Gilmore.

Application of B J Tierney was then read by the clerk, and it was moved and carried that the 52 head of 2-year-old steers assessed against him in Berwyn precinct be stricken from the assessment in Berwyn precinct as the same were assessed in Ansley precinct.

Balance of the forenoon was spent in committee work and at 12 m, the board adjourned till 1 p m.

Afternoon Session. Board met at 1 p m.

Committee No. 2 reported as follows upon the following protests that had been handed to them for consideration.

Upon the application of J M Fodge we recommend that the assessed valuation of southeast, northwest, east one-half southwest and lot 4 in section 19 town 18 range 23 be reduced to \$350.

And upon the application of S P Groat, we recommend that the assessed valuation on west one-half block 73 rr add to Broken Bow, be reduced \$50.00. M R Foster, Ben P. Morris, Committee.

It was moved and carried that the report of the committee be accepted and adopted as read.

Committee No 2 reported as follows:

lowing levies be made: Anselmo, 10 mills general. Merna, 10 mills gen, 5 mill bond.

Broken Bow, 18 mills gen 5 mill bond, 2 mill judg. Ansley, 10 mill gen 11 mill judg 6 mill bond.

C. Comstock, gen 20 mills. Sargent, gen 13 mills, bond 3 mills.

Oconto, general 10 mills. Callaway, general 15 mills bond 4 mills.

Arnold, general 10 mills.


