THE funeral of Junius Brutus Booth at Manchester-by-the-Sea, Thursday, was largely attended by relatives and professional friends. The interment was in Rose-lale cemetery.

THE construction of the main line of the B. & M. from Kenesaw west to Arapahoe, settles primarily the main line of this great line via Plattsmouth, Lincoln and Hastings, west to the Rockies, and ends all speculation as to the establishment of its main line via Tecumseh, Wymore, Red Cloud, and the Republican Valley.—Miner Gazette.

A SINGLE locomotive is now being built in the Sacramento car shops of the Central Pacific which will be larger than any ever before built in the world. The work is now half done. The engine will have five pair of driving wheels. The weight of the engine will be 75 tons; weight of drivers, 64 tons; weight of engine and tender when fully equipped for the road, 105 tons. The length of the engine and tender will be 65 feet 5 inches; driving wheel base, 19 feet 7 inches; diameter of cylinder, 21 inches; stroke, 26 inches; water capacity of tender, 3,000 gallons.—San Francisco Post.
