PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT.

The Following Proposed Amendment to the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, as Hereinafter Set Forth in Full, is Submitted to the Electors of McConnell & Berry's drug store. the State of Nebraska, to be Voted Upon at the General Election to be Held, Tuesday, November 4, 1902.

A Joint Resolution proposing to amend Secof the State of Nebraska, relative to the manner submitting and adopting amendments to the

onstitution of the said state of Nebraska. Be it resolved and enacted by the Legislature f the State of Nebraska: SECTION 1. That Section one of Article fifteen of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Either branch of the legislature may propose amendments to this constitution. and if the same be agreed to by three-lifths of the members elected to each house, such proposed amendments shall be entered on the Journals with the year and nays, and published at least once each week in at least one newspaper in each county where a newspaper is published, for thirty days immediately preceding the next election of senators and represeta-tives, at which election the same shall be subinited to the electors for approval or rejection, and if a majority of the electors voting at such election on such proposed amendment, shall vote to adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of this constitution. Whed more than one amendment is submitted at the same election, they shall be so submitted as to enable the electors to vote on each amendment separately.
