**Republican County Convention.**

The Republican electors of Red Willow county are hereby called to meet in delegate convention in the city of Indianola on Wednesday, August 23rd, at one o'clock p. m., for the purpose of selecting twelve delegates to the state convention and of placing in nomination candidates for the following offices: One county treasurer, one county clerk, one county judge, one county sheriff, one county superintendent, one county coroner, one county surveyor, and to transact such other business as may properly come before the convention.

Representation to the convention will be based on the votes cast for the Hon. Norris Brown for attorney general at the 1904 election, allowing one delegate for each 10 votes or major fraction thereof with one delegate at large from each voting precinct. On the above basis the several precincts will be entitled to representation as follows:
