State Taxes Less.

The total amount ofstate taxes charged against the several counties in 1909 and 1910 are respectively \$2,194,421.95 and \$2,059,842.70, or \$134,57.25 less this year than last. In 1909 Red Willow county was charged \$18,179.16; this year the figures are \$16,745.90, or a reduction of \$1,433.26. The amount of state taxes is based on a 5-mill levy. Total valuation is less in 1910.


