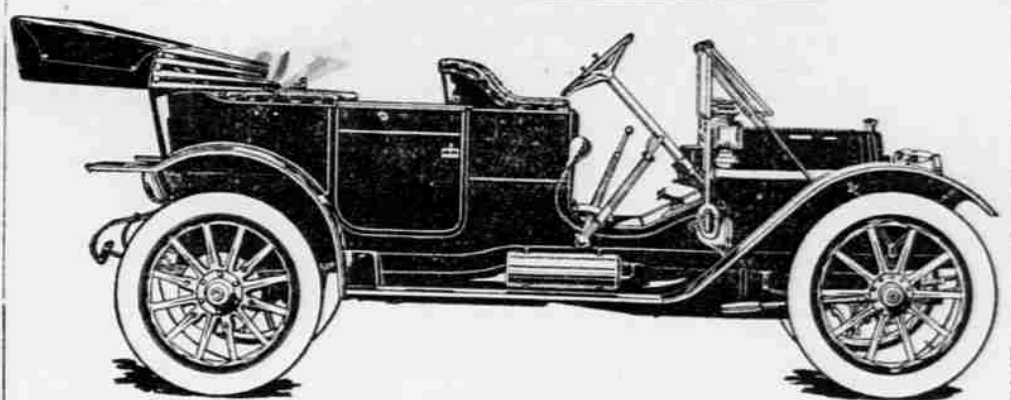
The young people of the Baptist church have purchased a piano for the use of the church and the bible school.
