### North Carolina's Oldest Lawsuit.

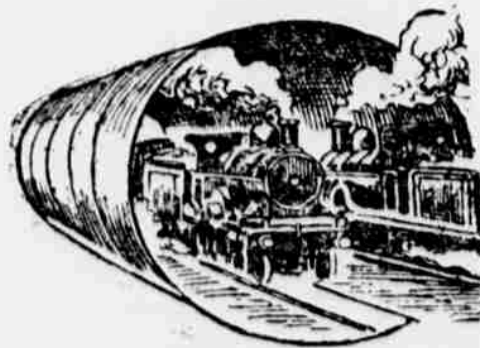
The oldest lawsuit in North Carolina is now being finally settled. It is that of the Eastern band of Cherokee Indians against W. H. Thomas and others, involving a great many thousand acres of land, and also other interests. Thomas was for some years before the civil war the chief of the Eastern band, and raised a legion of troops from among his Cherokees which was in the Confederate service, being one of the North Carolina regiments.

The case began in 1867, in the federal court for the western North Carolina district, and since that date over ninety attorneys have been employed. Every lawyer who was first employed has died.
