A Few Figures. The total appropriations made by the legislature for the last fusion biennium (1899-1900) for all the state institutions was \$1,167,709.00 and the average number of inmates in the institutions during this biennium was 2,642, making a per capita appropriation of \$441.60 for each inmate for the two years.

The total appropriations made by the last legislature for the present biennium (1905-1906) for all the state institutions was \$1,443,130.00, and the average number of inmates in the institutions up to June 1, 1906, was 3,568, making a per capita appropriation of \$404.47, for each inmate for two years.

This makes a difference of \$37.13 for each inmate in favor of the present republican administration. The number of inmates in all the state institutions on May 31, 1906, was 2,680, while the number of inmates on May 31, 1905, was 3,659, showing an increase in round numbers of 1,000.

In other words, had the appropriations for this republican biennium been as much for each state ward as they were for the last fusion biennium the total appropriations for the two years, 1905 and 1906, would have been \$132,479.84 more than they were.
