

Death of Mrs. Emma McCarroll at Union Home

Long Time Resident of Liberty Precinct Passes Away After Illness of Five Weeks.

Funeral services were held this afternoon at the Union Methodist church for Mrs. Emma McCarroll, 89, one of the long time residents of

that community. Rev. L. A. McCaughey, pastor of the church officiated at the services. The interment was at the East Union cemetery.

The deceased lady had been ill for the past five weeks, the last few days her condition offering but little hope of her recovery. She was born July 2, 1859, at Gallipolis, Ohio, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. D. B. Strait. She moved to Hamburg, Iowa, in 1872 and was married to John McCarroll at Nebraska City in 1891. Mr. McCarroll died at their farm home near Union August 22, 1929.

She was a member of the Methodist church at Union and the Royal Neighbors of America.

She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Louis Mougey, of Union, at whose home she had resided, and where she died Tuesday night; three children preceded her in death, Mrs. Fanny McQuinn, Mrs. Angie Everett and an infant daughter. Near relatives surviving include John McQuinn and Richard Mougey.
