RESOLUTION OF County Board Approving Withdrawal of Securities.

Resolved, that whereas the deposits of this county in Farmers State Bank of Avoca do not now exceed \$28,938.34 said bank is entitled to and is hereby permitted to withdraw the following securities held in escrow by First National Bank of Omaha, Nebr., (trustee) to secure deposits of this county in said bank, to-wit:
