## Hamburg Falls Without Fight to The Allies

Germans Evacuate the Nations Largest Seaport to Flee to Shelter of Norway

PARIS. -(U.P)- The Germans surrendered Hamburg, the reich's largest port and second city, without a fight today and began a mass flight by sea from the northern redoubt, presumably for a last stand in Norway.
