Hope to Prevent Loss of Cattle From "Pink Eye"

LINCOLN, (Special to The Daily Journal) - New hope for preventing thousands of cattle losses caused by "pink eye" was given Thursday with announcement of the discovery of the specific germ which causes this disease.

Officials of the American Foundation for Animal Health reported that veterinary research workers both at Ohio State University and Texas experiment station have found that the disease is due to a rod-shaped germ called "hemophilus bovis."

"In no instance was the germ found in the eyes of normal cattle," the report stated. "However, it was found that cattle which had apparently recovered from pink eye may serve as carriers and spread the disease for several months after recovery."

Authorities said today that discovery of the germ may make possible the development of a vaccine to combat this disease, but that much additional research will

43rd Division to Start Home Soon; Replaced by 9th

TOKYO, (UP) - Gen. Douglas MacArthur announced Thursday that the U. S. 43rd division, now stationed in the Yokohama area, would be sent home at an early date and replaced by the 97th division.

The 43rd is commanded by Maj. Gen. Leonard F. Wing of Rutland, Vt., and includes men from Maine, Vermont, Connecticut, and Rhode Island. It is a New England national guard division.

The 43rd went to the Pacific in October, 1942, and fought in the Solomons, New Guinea and on Luzon, New men in the division not eligible for return home will be transferred to other divisions. High point men in other divisions will thus be relieved for shipment home with the 43rd. It was also announced that the ship bringing the 97th, which served in Europe, to Japan will be used to return the 43rd to the United States.
