The same procedure was followed for the next six days at the Bayview hotel. Some women and girls were ravished in the main dining room in the presence of others detained by the Japanese.

Other girls were taken to the Boulevard, Alahambra and Miramar apartments for similar mas rape. Altogether, the orgy continued for eight days, with the victims including Filipinos, Chinese Russians and Spanish.


