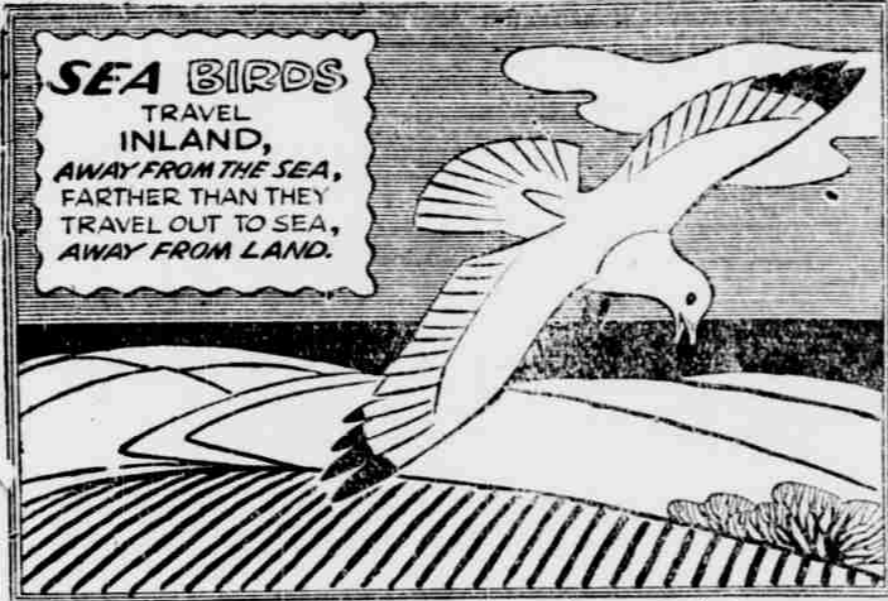

Ration Guide

SUGAR: War Ration Book IV, Sugar Stamp No. 38, good for five pounds, will remain valid through December 31. Home canned sugar coupons (GPA Form R-32) good for five pounds of sugar, may not be accepted from consumers by retailer after November 30, since they expire at that time.

55 pounds soft corn; 35 per cent moisture, 92 pounds corn. When corn shows 40 per cent moisture, 100 pounds of soft corn are needed to equal the feeding value in one bushel of No. 2. As the moisture content goes up, the amount of soft corn needed to equal the feeding value of one bushel of No. 2 corn goes up also.

up in glasses and sealed with paraffin, keeps well even though it is made with a smaller portion of sugar and with shorter cooking than most summer fruit jellies. It is easier to make because it jells so readily. To make this jelly, cook one quart (or one pound) of cranberries and one and one-half cups of water rapidly in saucepan about 15 minutes or until the berries are soft. Strain through a fine sieve, add two cups of sugar, stir and cook about three minutes, or until the juice gives the two-drop jelly test from a spoon. Pour into hot clean glasses and let stand until cool and "set". Cover with paraffin. Store in a cool, dry, dark place.

PRICE Price controls have been suspended on the following citrus fruit: oranges, lemons, grapefruits, and tangerines. Area Pricing Orders are being issued by Omaha, effective December 1, and Lincoln, effective December 10th, covering various Hard Building Materials. It was announced this week by OPA. These orders establish dollar-and-cent prices for those building materials listed in the orders and these prices must be posted in a prominent place in each retail establishment selling the items.

Major problems the county agricultural and home demonstration agent propose to deal with in Fillmore county during 1946 are: A balanced farm and home program with emphasis placed on educational programs, on conservation, and the use of farm and home accounts and improved livestock. Farmstead and home improvement is another problem to be approached. To accomplish this goal, plans have been made for meetings on farm buildings and machinery repair, kitchen clinics, refinishing of floors and furniture, construction of septic tanks and wiring and selection of lighting fixtures for rural electrification.

Notes on Nebraska Farming. Feeding Value of Soft Corn. The dry matter in soft corn is as valuable for feed as an equal amount of dry matter in mature corn, says Otis County Agricultural Agent A. H. DeLong. Gains will usually be slower on the soft corn because cattle will consume less actual dry matter. In determining the feeding value of soft corn, the moisture content can be used to estimate the amount of dry matter it contains. The following table, recently published by the Fremont National Bank, shows the weights of soft corn needed to provide a feeding value equal to one bushel of No. 2 corn.
