ished price control. It has been their belief that if we give production a free range that supply and demand will adjust prices to normal. This writer cannot go along with the theory because the laws of supply and demand do not control prices, but rather supply and demand are controlled by prices. This thought is best illustrated as follows: if at the present, automobiles were selling for \$15,000 instead of \$2,000, supply would now be ahead of demand because high prices have reduced the number of purchasers who have \$10,000 for the purchase of an automobile. Whereas, on the other hand, if automobiles sold for \$100 instead of their present prices, it would take an indefinite period of time, if ever, for supply to catch up with demand. It can therefore be readily seen that the Republican propaganda of supply and demand adjusting prices is without foundation and that unless we have some type of assistance in the control of sky-rocketing prices, that supply and demand will never meet.

I wonder if the Cass County farmers are satisfied with the Republican agriculture program. Does praise to the University of Nebraska in the Republican platform promise the farmers anything definite? We have had but one definite word from the Republicans on the agriculture program and those were the words of Taft which we all remember. This writer wants to know if the Nebraska Republicans are going to repudiate Taft or if they are going to repudiate the farmers.
