

### Annual Meet of First Church Christ, Scientist

BOSTON, Mass. — Declaring that democratic government is the instrument through which an irresistible, spiritual force is being channeled into the affairs of men, The Christian Science Board of Directors urged Christian Scientists, in annual meeting to work strongly and actively for the defense of free governments throughout the world.

Rightly conceived, the Directors told the Annual Meeting of The Mother Church, The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Massachusetts, democratic government is something more than an aggregation of legislative acts and legalized rules of conduct.

"It is an orderly unfolding of the moral character and spiritual integrity of its citizens," the spokesmen for the worldwide Christian Science movement affirmed. As such, they merit active defense of its sacred purpose, in addition to the pious declarations of allegiance to its outer form.

Thousands of Christian Scientists from many parts of the world heard the Directors issue a distinct challenge to the proud, boastful "Goliaths of today," as they go to aid in the earth. Denying God, they are denying their own life, for God is the only life of man," they stated.

In free governments, now seriously endangered by the modern Goliaths, the Directors commented, there is a force that gathers its strength from "the same eternal truth given by Christ Jesus in his peerless Sermon on the Mount." Ultimately it shall be seen, they said, that "no individual or nation on earth can withstand the power and presence of God and His Christ."

The Directors' statement highlighted a series of aers and reports made to the Annual Meeting. Set against the background of the great Mother Church dome and the Church park resplendent with mid-Spring blooms, the reports stressed the renaissance of

religious activities throughout the postwar world, and reemphasized the privileges of free assembly and freedom of worship as the human symbols of "spiritual freedom."

With the warnings of serious dangers to democratic government, the Directors also gave assurance that the antagonists of free government, like the Goliaths of old, were merely "inviting their own doom."

The Israelites of old were faced with similar problems, the Directors continued. Confronted with seeming extermination by the overwhelming armies of the Philistines, who sent forth Goliath to intimidate them, they did not quail, the statement said. Did Goliath succeed in defying the armies of the living God? No!

"He fell a victim of his own false trust. The Christ, Truth, guided the hand of the shepherd boy, and the enemy was slain through David's absolute trust in the power of God."

**KITCHEN TRICK**

Boil potatoes in their skins, peel and mash. Crumble oven-dried bread; brown bread crumbs and onion in shortening, add celery and parsley. Cook slowly 10 mins. Stir beaten egg into mashed potatoes, add balance of ingredients, season. Place in greased pan, bake in oven with roast 20 mins. Baste with pan drippings, stirring as you baste.
