The Board of Education, School District No. 1 of Cass County met in a regular session on Tuesday evening, October 5, 1948 in the Superintendent's office in the High School Building with the following members present: Frank A. Clout, President, John Schreiner, Secretary, William Evers, A. B. Rogers, A. W. Huebner, Dr. O. C. Hudson, and T. I. Friest, Superintendent. NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION
PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that pursuant to a resolution duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Cass County, Nebraska, and entered of record in the minutes of their proceedings a Special Election is hereby called and will be held in the County of Cass, Nebraska on the 2nd day of November, 1948.

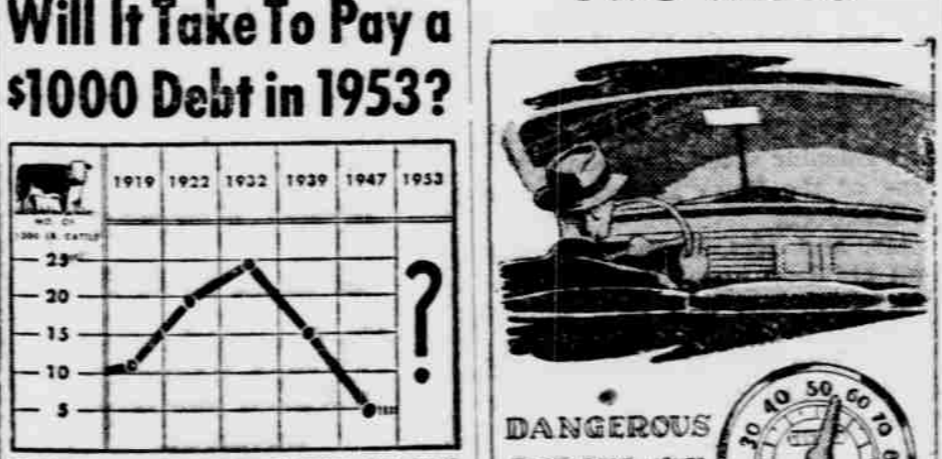
At said Special Election there will be submitted to the legal voters of said County, the following proposition:

"Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Cass County, Nebraska, beginning in the year 1949, and for four additional years thereafter, exceed the levy of fifty cents on the one hundred dollar valuation fixed by Section 23-119 of the Revised Statutes of Nebraska for 1943, by levying one and four-tenths mills on the dollar valuation of all tangible property in Cass County, Nebraska for construction, repair and maintenance of roads, and one and six-tenths mills on the dollar valuation of all tangible property in Cass County, Nebraska for the construction, maintenance and repair of bridges, all in addition to the levy authorized by law for county purposes and in addition to the legal levy limits, provided, however, the total levy for bridge purposes shall not exceed one and six-tenths mills and the total levy for county road purposes shall not exceed one and seven-tenths mills, including the levies herein authorized?"

Voters desiring to vote in favor of said proposition will mark an "X" in the square following the words "For said proposition"; voters desiring to vote against said proposition will mark an "X" in the square following the words "Against said proposition."
