Board met pursuant to adjournment. Present, Parr Young and A. G. Reid. County Commissioners, and Geo. R. Sayles. County Clerk. Absent, W. F. Nolte, Commissioner First District.

Minutes of last session read and approved, when the following business was transacted in regular form:

RESOLUTION WHEREAS, Richard C. Peck, County Veterans Service Officer of Cass County, Nebraska, will be required to spend funds as appropriated in the Soldiers' and Sailors' Relief Fund of said county, as demands are made upon him, and

WHEREAS, authority should be granted to the County Treasurer of Cass County, Nebraska, to make payment to the said County Veterans Service Officer as expeditiously as possible.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County Treasurer of Cass County, Nebraska, be and she hereby is authorized to transfer to Richard C. Peck, Cass County Veterans Service Officer, sums not to exceed \$500.00 at any one time, on written application directed to the County Treasurer of Cass County, Nebraska, signed by the Chairman and Secretary of the County Veterans Service Committee, said sums to be used by the County Veterans Service Officer in the discharge of his duties as such officer.
