Fat cattle Monday at Omaha sold steady to strong, hogs and lambs steady to 25c up. Omaha's run totalled 22,000 to rank No. 1 nationally. Tuesday's pattern of trade was varied—fat cattle steady to 25c off, hogs 25-50c lower, and lightweight lambs strong to 35c higher, others steady.

In fat cattle trade best action was on weights 1,000 pounds down. Bulk brought \$24.00-\$25.50, with weighty steers to \$23.50, heifers to \$23.50, plain to medium shorts to \$22.00-\$24.50.

Most butcher hogs weighing 180-360 Tuesday at Omaha were bracketed at \$14.50-\$16.25, a few \$16.35 and \$16.40. Monday's top was \$17.50.
