The Cass County Board of Equalization met pursuant to adjournment. Present: Parr Young, A. G. Reid and W. F. Nolte, county Commissioners; Geo. R. Sayles, County Clerk and W. H. Puls, County Assessor.

Mr. Tom Smith, fieldman with the State Tax Commissioner's Office was also present.
