

## Elmwood Six-Man Grid Team Slates Eight Games

Practice session switched from six o'clock in the afternoon to three o'clock for Coach John Johnston's Elmwood high school six-man grid team this week with the opening of school.

Getting in a shape after a week of the evening sessions, the 12-man squad is prepping for its opening with St. Joseph's of York, September 13.

Six lettermen, only two of whom are seniors, provide Johnston with material around which his team will be built. Two-year lettermen are Keith Bornemeier, 133-pound end, Dudley Doebele, 151-pound back, John Thomas, 170-pound center, and Murrell McCoy, 178-pound back. Bornemeier and Doebele are juniors, and Thomas and McCoy, seniors. Other lettermen are Orville Bogenreif, 139-pound sophomore back, and Keith Drake, 151-pound sophomore back.

The Elmwood schedule following the opener against St. Joseph includes: September 21, at Ceresco; September 28, Underwood; October 5, Union; October 12, Dunbar; October 19, Nehawka; October 24, at Alvo; and October 31, Eagle. Only three of the eight games are away from home, and Elmwood will play four straight on the home field.

Other squad members are Dick Apt, 133-pound sophomore end; Merle Backemeyer, 110-pound sophomore end; Eldro Hansen, 93-pound freshman back; Ronnie Irons, 110-pound sophomore back; Larry Lannin, 150-pound senior end; and Clark Marshall, 140-pound freshman back.
