You and I need to know more about Communism—if we are to combat it effectively in America. For the moment, let us disregard our Government's efforts overseas on Communism. We can do little about that so long as Congress listens to Achenso's propaganda. Let's take a look at things at home.

On December 27, 1929, J. Stalin made a speech titled "The Policy of Eliminating the Kulaks as a Class." It is found in his book, "Problems of Leninism." The passage quoted is found on page 322.

"Squeezing out the capitalist elements in the rural districts means squeezing out and over-

Will you read those lines by Stalin over again, please? In them are found the basic strategy used by the Communists to destroy the great middle-class farm population in Russia. Do you see any resemblance between those tactics—and what goes on in America today?

Most adult Americans are rapidly becoming familiar with "the pressure of taxation"—except those who have the right new Deal connections. Likewise we are learning what "restrictive measures" in the form of OPA and other regimentation can do to destroy individual freedom.

The disease that undermines our strength is not Communism abroad. It is the adoption here of Communistic ideas. Carboic acid is a quick method of suicide, regardless of the nationality or intentions of the person who takes it. Likewise Communistic policies—including cruel taxation and regimentation of agriculture—will lead inevitably to a Communist government. Stalin has made that clear for us.
