ORDINANCE NO. 869

AN ORDINANCE CREATING STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER 104 IN THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA, DEFINING ITS BOUNDARIES AND PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF CERTAIN STREETS BY PAVING AND SUCH OTHER WORK AS MAY BE INCIDENTAL THERE TO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Council of the City of Plattsmouth, in the County of Cass, State of Nebraska, hereby find and determine that the streets hereinafter ordered to be

improved are main thoroughfares that form a part of the State Highway System.

Section 2. There is hereby created within the City of Plattsmouth, Nebraska, a street improvement district to be known and designated as Street Improvement District No. 104, the outer boundaries of which are as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of a line 140 feet southwest and west of the southwest and west property line of Webster Boulevard and a line at right angles to the center line of Webster Boulevard at a point 200 feet northwest of the north property line of Avenue "D", also known as Elm Street, as measured along the center line of Webster Boulevard;

Thence in a northeasterly direction along the said line at right angles to the center line of Webster Boulevard to its intersection with a line 140 feet northeast and east of the northeast and east property line of Webster Boulevard;

Thence in a southeasterly direction along the said line 140 feet northeast and east of the northeast and east property line of Webster Boulevard to its intersection with the south property line of the east and west alley in Block 9 of Young and Hays Addition to the original Town of City of Plattsmouth, Nebraska;

Thence east along the south property line extended of the said alley to its intersection with a line extended which is 140 feet northeast of and parallel to the northeast property line of Washington Avenue;

Thence in a southeasterly direction along the said line 140 feet northeast of and parallel to the northeast property line of Washington Avenue to its intersection with the west property line of Seventh Street;

Thence south along the west property line of Seventh Street to its intersection with the north property line of Avenue "A", also known as Vine Street;

Thence west along the north property line of said Avenue "A" to its intersection with a line 140 feet southwest of and parallel to the southwest property line of Washington Avenue;

Thence in a northeasterly direction along the said line 140 feet southwest of and parallel to the southwest property line of Washington Avenue to its intersection with the north property line of the east and west alley in Block 12 in Young and Hays Addition to the City of Plattsmouth, Nebraska;

Thence west along the north property line of the east and west alley in said Block 12 to its intersection with a line 140 feet southwest of and parallel to the southwest property line of Webster Boulevard;

Thence in a northwesterly direction along the said line 140 feet southwest of and parallel to the southwest property line of Webster Boulevard to the point of beginning.

Section 3. The following streets within said Street Improvement District No. 104 shall be and hereby are ordered improved by repaving, to-wit:

WEBSTER BOULEVARD from the north property line of Avenue "D", also known as Elm Street, a distance of 200 feet together with all included intersections.

AVENUE "D", also known as Elm Street from the south property line of Avenue "D" at its intersection with the north property line of Washington Avenue to the southwest property line extended of Webster Boulevard together with all included intersections.

WASHINGTON AVENUE from the north property line of Avenue "A", also known as Vine Street, to the south property line of Avenue "D", also known as Elm Street, together with all included intersections.

All work essential for or necessarily incidental to the construction of said improvements shall be done in connection therewith as a part thereof.

Section 4. All of said improvements shall be constructed to the established grades as fixed by ordinance of said City and shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications to be made by Henningson, Durham & Richardson, Inc., Special Engineer, employed by the City, and to be approved by the Council. Said improvements shall be made at public cost but special assessments on the specially benefited property shall be levied to reimburse
