ORDINANCE NO. 66
An ordinance to provide an annual appropriation for the use and benefit of the Village of Nehawka for the fiscal year ending May 1, 1953.
Be it ordained by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Nehawka, That there be levied for the use and benefit of the Village of Nehawka, Nebraska, for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1952, a tax upon all property, real and personal and mixed within the corporate limits of said villages as follows: For general purpose fund, 10 mills; for the purpose of maintaining streets and alleys, 4 1/2 mills; for electrical energy, 1 1/2 mills; for fire equipment, 3 mills; for retiring water bonds, 5 mills.
Section II. The purpose to which money arising from the levy mentioned in the foregoing section and the rate of apportionment shall be as follows:
General revenue purposes to each \$1.00 valuation, 4 1/2 mills for maintenance of streets and alleys; 1 1/2 mills for electrical energy; 3 mills for fire equipment; 5 mills for retiring water bonds.

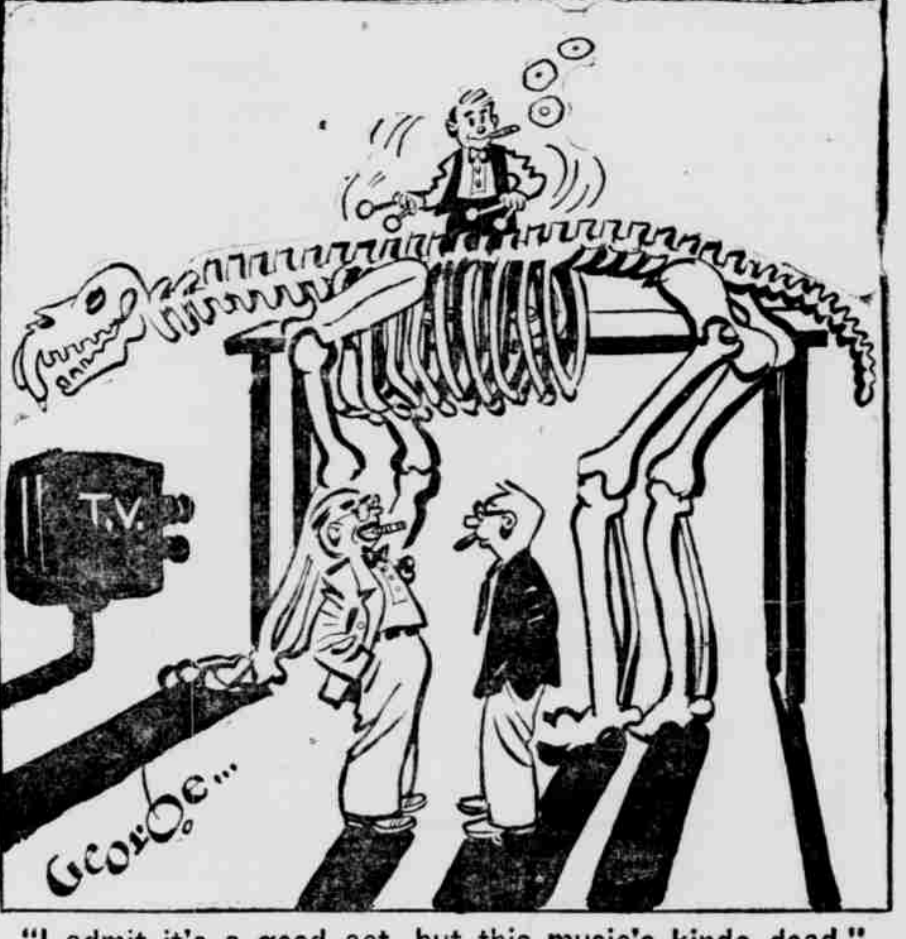
