Rieke's Hogs Top Omaha Market; Prices Are Up
 Livestock values Monday at Omaha ranged from steady to higher. Slaughter steers, yearlings and heifers sold mostly steady, scattered early sales strong, replacement cattle and calves unevenly higher. Hogs were strong to mostly 25 cents higher and fat lambs were strong to 50 cents up.
 Among recent sales at Omaha for shippers from this area were Emil W. Rieke, 9 hogs weighing 207 at \$21.65, tops for March 4; Warren Rikli, 33 hogs weighing 238 at \$20.50; Lester Wagner, 13 hogs weighing 202 at \$20.75; Stanley Lepert, 21 hogs weighing 235 at \$20.50; Otto Fleischmann, 32 hogs weighing 198 at \$20.25; L. B. Gegey & Son, 42 hogs weighing 237 at \$21.25; and 23 weighing 248 at \$19.50; Rikli & Son, 30 hogs weighing 247 at \$20.25; Gene Nolting, 35 hogs weighing 204 at \$21.15; Kenneth Todd, 14 hogs weighing 251 at \$20.50; and A. Webber, 19 hogs weighing 323 at \$19.

CANNED AIRCRAFT
