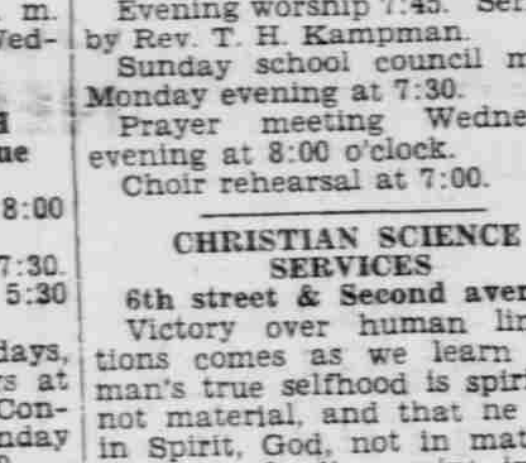
POPULATION SHIFT
The advice of Horace Greeley's "Go West, Young Man," seems to be still followed today. A study, recently released by the Census Bureau, showed that states in the West had the greatest population growth in the last three years. Nevada gained 24.5 percent; Arizona, 20.7; California, 14.2; New Mexico, 11.1; Colorado, 9.9; Wyoming, 9.2; Utah, 8.9; and Texas, 8.9. In the nation as a whole the population grew during 1953 by an estimated 2,700,000 placing the population well over the 160,000,000 mark.
