**OUT OLD NEBRASKA**

STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Daniel Gantt, who served as chief justice of the supreme court from January to May, 1878, was born in Perry County, Pennsylvania, June 29, 1814. He spent his boyhood in Perry County, including in his education the study of law. He practiced law in Pennsylvania for a while, but in 1857 moved to the new territory of Nebraska, settling at Saratoga, about three miles north of Omaha.

Like many other territorial pioneers, he plunged immediately into the political life of the new territory. He was a candidate for the legislature in 1857, but was defeated. He moved to Omaha and in 1861 was elected city treasurer, a post he held for three years. He ran for the legislature again in 1863, and was elected. As a member of the Ninth Legislature, he ardently supported the basic Republican measures before that Congress for an enabling act to permit the people of the territory to draft a constitution. (The question of statehood was hotly fought in 1864, with the advocates of statehood being defeated.)

President Lincoln appointed Mr. Gantt United States Attorney in 1864. One of his achievements in that office was to prosecute successfully lottery swindlers then operating in the territory. In 1863, the Gantts removed to Nebraska City, and Mr. Gantt entered the practice of law. He also lectured at Otoe University, the short-lived Presbyterian College at Nebraska City.

Mr. Gantt was elected an associate justice of the supreme court in 1872. At that time a supreme court justice served as a district judge also, making the circuit of the various counties in his district. At stated times the judges met at the supreme court in the capitol.

Judge Gantt's health was poor when he became a member of the court, but he did his work faithfully, serving the southeastern district. The constitution of 1875, providing for district judges, relieved the supreme court justices of the duty of riding the circuit.

Judge Gantt was re-elected to the supreme court under the constitution of 1875, and in January, 1878, became chief justice. He died at his home in Nebraska City, May 29, 1878, having served less than five months as chief justice.

Judge Gantt was a member of the Presbyterian church and one of the early members of the Odd Fellows lodge in Nebraska. He took a great deal of interest in building up the order in Nebraska.
