Corn In Storage Loses Vitamin A, Professor Explains

Corn kept under good storage conditions will retain its protein and energy content fairly well but the carotene-chemical substances present in many feeds which animals convert to vitamin A—content will decrease as the storage period progresses, according to J. Matsushima, assistant professor of the University of Nebraska.

Recent tests carried out by the Bureau of Animal Industry at the U. S. Department of Agriculture's Research Center at Beltsville, Maryland, indicate that stored corn is not a dependable source of the important A vitamin, so essential in maintaining the health of livestock.

Green forage is one of the best sources of carotene or provitamin A, says Matsushima, but when this is not available, alfalfa leaf meal or any good quality leaf hay, especially alfalfa hay, can be substituted to supply this important food element. Good quality grass or corn silage is also a good source of carotene.

Farmers who use commercial feed mixtures should check the label to determine that some source of carotene other than corn is present, Matsushima says. Some feeds contain a crystalline or pure form of vitamin. Other commercial feeds are fortified with fish oils to furnish vitamin A. In some instances the vitamin A content is stated on the label. Freshness is important, Matsushima emphasizes, since ground feeds tend to lose their carotene and/or vitamin A content with ages.

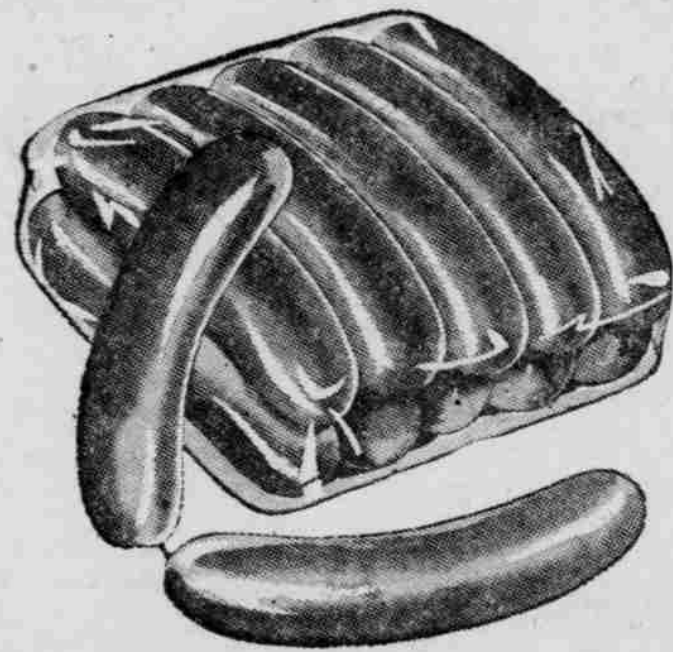
