Varietal Tests Available for Fall Small Grains

Farmers producing fall sown grains may have a progress report of varietal tests of winter wheat, winter barley and rye by asking their agricultural extension agent for Outstate Testing Circular 37.
The performance of these fall sown grain varieties in Outstate Tests together with results for the same varieties at the Experiment Stations and Experiment Farms are included in this circular.
This report is the first of the 1954 series presenting results of varietal and fertilizer tests conducted throughout Nebraska by the Agronomy Department of the Agricultural Experiment Station. Results of experiments with fertilizers for winter wheat, spring small grain varieties, and fertilizer experiments with spring small grains will be available as soon as compilation of data is completed say the agronomists.
