Louis Schwegman, Long - Time Resident

Louis Schwegman, the son of Diedrich Schwegman and Margaret Ketenkamp, was born in Lancaster County, Nebraska, Nov. 23, 1873, and died Dec. 4, 1954.

He lived on the farm with his parents and later farmed for himself, as well as helping with other work in the community. His home was southwest of Eagle, until 1921, when he moved to Eagle with his mother and sister.

Louis Schwegman was baptized on April 6, 1874, in the Lutheran church, and was confirmed as a communicant member at the age of 16 in Lincoln. For many years he was a member of Trinity Lutheran church north of Bennet, and after moving to Eagle transferred to Immanuel Lutheran church.

He was a faithful member of this congregation for many years, serving for a long time as custodian of the church. He took an active part in the work of the church and found joy in attending services, until poor health prevented him from attending. He passed away quietly in his home at Eagle, having reached the age of 81 years and 11 days.

He leaves his sister, Mrs. Sophie Burge of Bennet, brothers, Frederick, Diedrich, Albert and August of Eagle; one niece, Gladys, and one nephew, Merlin, both of California, as well as many other relatives and friends.

Funeral services were held at Immanuel Lutheran church in Eagle, and burial at Trinity cemetery near Walton. Officiating pastor was D. F. Luebke.

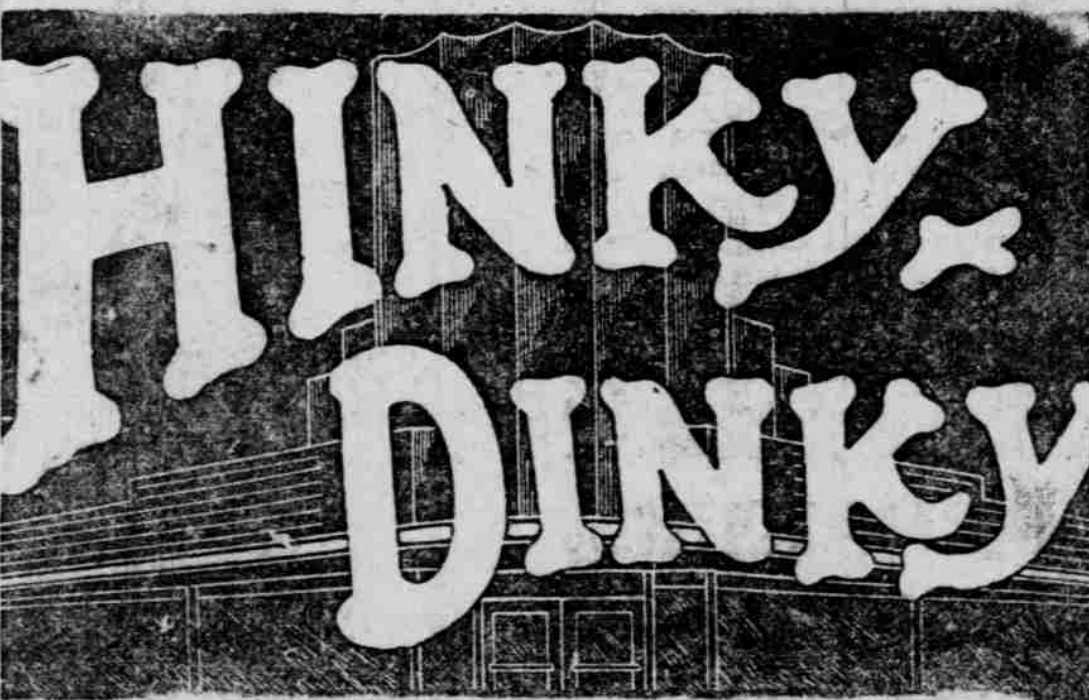
