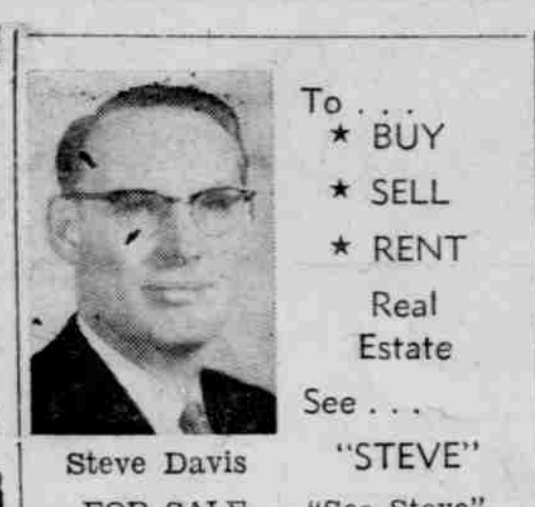

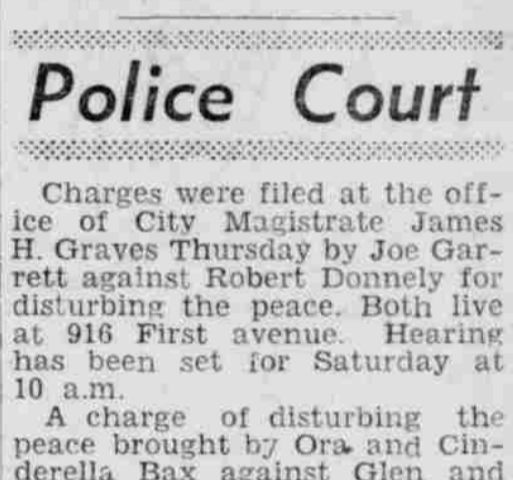
Hammons Services Held at Weeping Water on May 7
