BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Mayor and City Council of the City of Plattsmouth, Nebraska: Section 1. The Mayor and City Council of the City of Plattsmouth in the County of Cass, State of Nebraska, hereby find and declare that it is to the best interests of the said city to

create Street Improvement District No. 127.  
Section 2. There is hereby created within the City of Plattsmouth, Nebraska, a Street Improvement District to be known and designated as Street Improvement District No. 127, the outer boundaries of which are as follows:

All of said improvements shall be constructed to the established grades as fixed by ordinance of said city and shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications to be made by Elmer Gochour, Special Engineer employed by the city and to be approved by the council. Said improvement shall be made at public cost but special improvement assessments on the specially benefited property shall be levied to reimburse the city to the extent provided by law.
