#### Jacob Shows **How Religion Betters Us**

TACOB at his worst was one of the meanest and shiftiest characters on record, either in Holy Writ or in the secular records of human life. He tricked his elder brother, Esau, out of the birthright, and in other incidents he showed himself a cowardly

and selfish man. But Jacob at his best proved to be a man upon whom something could be built, whereas the more likeable, good-natured Esau, like many likeable, good-natured men, was weak. He was undependable, unwilling to bear much

responsibility. And also, Jacob at his best had some remarkable spiritual experiences. Perhaps the Bible tells us so much about Jacob, at his worst and at his best and about these experiences, because even mean and shifty men can be saved from their meanness and shiftiness. They can have visions of ladders reaching to heaven, and can find God. For God is no respecter of persons, and he does help those who call upon Him in sincerity and truth, even if their character and past conduct have not been what they ought to have

A man who begins to be religious can get a better religious experience-a better religion. He can grow in grace.

It is the man who never makes a beginning who comes to nothing. Jacob DID come to something better. Bethel was the first step; Peniel (Genesis) saw him really a changed man.
