Board met pursuant to adjournment. Present: R. E. Norris, H. L. Bornemeier and W. F. Nolte, Commissioners and Chas. Land, County Clerk.

Minutes of the last session approved and the following business was transacted in regular form:

The appointment of Polly Saltmarsh as Deputy Register of Deeds was approved by the Board.

Resolution passed recalling and canceling the appointment of Raymond J. Case as member

of the County Service Committee for failure of the Board to give proper notice as required by law, and the County Clerk was instructed to notify all veterans' organizations in the County of such vacancy and inform them that a recommended list may be submitted in accordance with Sec. 80-101, R.S. Supp. 1955 on or before October 15, 1956.

It was further resolved that by reason of the death of Gene Roddy of Union, Nebraska, a member of the County Service Committee, a vacancy occurs for his term which expires July 1, 1958, and that all veterans' organizations be notified, and may submit lists of names to fill this vacancy, as per Sec. 80-101, R.S. Supp. 1955.
