## NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

A special election has been called and will be held on the 6th day of November, 1956, in the City of Plattsmouth, Nebraska, at which time there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City the following proposition, to wit:

"Shall the City of Plattsmouth, Nebraska, pledge its credit and issue its negotiable bonds in the principal amount of not exceeding Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00), to provide funds for the acquiring of title to real estate and building a swimming pool thereon, the amount, maturity and interest the bonds shall carry to be fixed by the Mayor and Council at the time of issuance, but said bonds shall mature in not to exceed twenty years from this date and shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding six per cent per annum, payable annually, and

Shall the City of Plattsmouth, Nebraska, cause to be levied annually taxes by valuation on all the taxable property in the city in addition to other taxes at a rate sufficient to pay the interest and principal of said bonds as the same become due."
