Relax A Bit Before Bedtime To Sleep Well At Night
If you will taper off the day's activities during the evening rather than go at full tilt up to bedtime, you are more liable to fall asleep quickly and rest more satisfactorily, according to a former medical chief at the Mayo Clinic.

"Going to sleep is like stopping one's car at a boulevard," he says. "If, when a block away, one sees the light change to red, one should turn off the power and coast to a stop. Some persons keep the power on until they almost reach the light and then slam on the brakes."

The doctor feels the person who spends a restless evening is likely to fall asleep the minute his head touches the pillow. "But the one who works hard until 10 o'clock or gets jittery watching a prizefight on television may well need a sleeping pill as a brake."

The poor sleeper must take special care. He should go to bed early to rest or read, to coast to a stop. He should be comfortable, firmly supported here is the important point. If, when drowsiness comes, a person can turn out the light and lay right down, he is likely to go to sleep."
