"Seven Hills Of Rome" Coming To Cass Theatre

For the first time in history a motion picture crew making a feature-length film crossed the broad white line dividing the Vatican City State from the Republic of Italy when a sequence in St. Peter's Square was filmed for "Seven Hills of Rome," new Mario Lanza musical romance made in Italy for M-G-M. This will be at the Cass Theater May 23-27. The film-makers, headed by Director Roy Rowland and stars Lanza, his glamorous new leading lady, Marisa Allasio, and the popular Italian character actor, Renato Rascel, had set up shop at 6 A. M. in the celebrated square virtually beneath the bedroom windows of Pope Pius XI.

An hour and a half later, the white robed figure of the Pope himself, unnoticed by all but a few appeared fleetingly at his windows and for perhaps ten seconds gazed down into the great square which electricians and grips had transformed into an arched set for their operations.

While many documentary films and newsreels have been made within the confines of the tiny church state, "Seven Hills of Rome" is the first feature-length picture using professional actors ever to be permitted use of any part of Vatican City as a set. Other films have the domes of St. Peter's in the background of a scene and have filmed action near the Vatican but all were careful to keep their equipment on the Italian side of the easiest crossed frontier in the world.

Operators of Postal vehicles in the three-state Wichita Region, (including Nebraska) continued last year to be the safest in the nation, according to Frank Barr, Regional Operations Director for Kansas, Oklahoma and Nebraska.

For fiscal year 1957 the motor vehicle accident rate for the Wichita Region was 57 accidents for every 100,000 miles driven, with a casualty rate on only .03 and an average cost of only \$75.07.
