A two car accident 10 miles south of Plattsmouth Friday resulted in injuries to one passenger.

A northbound car, pulling a trailer containing a show horse, was being driven by Allen Walker of Dunbar. Walker was enroute with his wife to Plattsmouth for a street showing of his horse (Judy Garland) during the KKK.

Walker's trailer developed a flat tire so he pulled off the road onto the east shoulder. He then pulled back onto the highway and across it to the west and was in the process of pulling into a farm driveway on the west side of the road when the accident occurred. Sheriff Tom Solomon said.

The southbound car driven by Lowell D. Riecke of Union. Riecke told Solomon he saw the Walker car pull back onto the highway and assumed it would continue north. Walker said he did not see the oncoming Riecke car before he made his left turn.

Mrs. Glyde Walker received internal injuries and was treated by a Plattsmouth doctor. Walker still managed to drive his damaged car to Plattsmouth in order to keep his KKK date.

Casey commented on life in England, Germany and Spain and attitudes toward Americans in those countries.

Casey commented that he thought wrong impressions of America and Americans are being spread by conduct by some Americans abroad. He said it would be well for this country to give some attention to the ones it is allowing to leave the country as well as those permitted to come in.
