 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 885 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 8. Licenses shall not be recommended by the Mayor and City Council for the sale of alcoholic liquors on any premises not located within the following described areas or fractions thereof to-wit:

The South One-half of Block 27; the East one-half of Block 28, 29, and 30; the North one-half of Blocks 33 and 35; all of Block 34; the East one-half of Block 36, all in the Original Town of Plattsmouth, Nebraska, and Winteret Addition, an Addition to the City of Plattsmouth, Cass County, Nebraska."

Section 2. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 885 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage approval of publication as provided by law. Passed and approved this 29th day of July, 1959.

ORDINANCE NO. 981
 AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE POLICY OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH WITH REFERENCE TO THE NUMBER OF CERTAIN TYPES OF LIQUOR LICENSES WHICH SHALL BE GRANTED IN SAID CITY. TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 821, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH:

Section 1. That hereafter it shall be the policy of the City Council of the City of Plattsmouth to recommend the granting of licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquors to not more than the number of applicants hereinafter set out, to-wit:

Class "A" beer licenses, not more than 2 such licenses to be in effect at any time;

Class "C" license, not more than 3 such licenses to be in effect at any time;

Class "D" license, not more than 1 such license to be in effect at any time.

Section 2. The limitations herein contained shall apply only to persons, firms or corporations engaged in such business for profit, and shall in no manner restrict the number of licenses of any type to be granted or recommended for bona fide veterans' organizations or service club clubs not organized for profit, but the City Council reserves the right to determine the nature of such organizations which shall be eligible to receive licenses under this provision.

Section 3. Ordinance Number 821 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law. Passed and approved this 29th day of July, 1959.
