When good quality hay is properly stored in a dry place, it will retain most of its nutritional qualities for at least 45 years, according to a recent chemical analysis of 45-year-old hay at Kansas State University, Manhattan, Kans. The protein content was found to be 19 per cent, 3 or 4 per cent above the protein content of average fresh hay. Crude fiber content was 21-24 per cent which is lower than normal indicating that the hay was of excellent quality when it was stored. The hay used in the test came from an old barn on a farm near Wauneta, Kans.
