This 'n That In Agriculture

Tests at the University of Nebraska Agriculture Experiment Station indicate that corn dried with artificial heat not exceeding 190 degrees makes good cattle feed.

Digestion trials showed no significant differences between lots of corn dried naturally as compared with that dried by artificial heat at temperatures of 130, 160 or 190 degrees.

The studies indicated that there was no nutrient loss in heat dried corn nor less in digestibility of rations containing heat dried corn.

All Nebraska farmers are being asked to take an active part in a statewide cornpicker safety campaign this fall.

And you'll have the most active role to play in this campaign, because you will be operating the picker, safely or otherwise, says Delbert Lane, Extension agricultural engineer at the University of Nebraska.

Full cooperation of newspaper, radio station and television station editors will be sought to bring the message of cornpicker safety into every Nebraska farm home.

Each year hundreds of farmers all over the country are killed, injured or maimed for life in cornpicker accidents. These accidents are extremely costly in money, loss of time and suffering by the farmer and his family.

Don't let your name be listed on the cornpicker accident report for 1959. Clarence Schmadcke, County Extension Agent.

Capitol News

The Nebraska Press Association LINCOLN — There has been a lot of talk about investigations in the capital city.

The highway department, purchasing department and mental hospitals all have had a taste of it.

Reports are that Gov. Ralph G. Brooks is considering naming a committee of state senators to look into highway department operations.

Sen. Terry Carpenter, of Scottsbluff apparently beat the governor to the punch in announcing this.

But Carpenter's announcement was far from complimentary to the governor.

He says Brooks has no business naming senators to such a committee when the legislature itself voted against such a probe.

Also, Carpenter says the proposed investigation is designed to throttle him. The Scottsbluff senator says he has been looking into the department and will have a few things to say about it himself.

Fred Herrington, a Republican, kicked off a gubernatorial inquiry into state purchasing practices.

In a letter to purchasing agent A. Clifford Anderson, a Democrat, the tax commissioner ordered his personal clearance of any purchases above \$35 which were not let for bids.

Herrington says he has received complaints that certain with state business without submitting bids.

Involved in the controversy are some chairs in the governor's office, in the mansion and some desks in the motor vehicle department.

Governor Brooks ordered an immediate study of state buying practices.

Superintendents of the three state mental hospitals were called before the governor to tighten custody of sexual psychopaths.

The governor was told by the superintendents that 18 sexual psychopaths have escaped from the three state hospitals and have never been heard of since.

Thirteen fled from the Lincoln state Hospital, two from Hastings and three from Norfolk.

The governor heard Board of Control Chairman Charles Ledeman charge that law enforcement agencies apparently do not follow through when they escapees are reported.
