WHEREAS pursuant to direction of the Board of County Commissioners of Cass County, Nebraska, by motion duly passed in the Commissioners Proceedings on May 3, 1960, the County Superintendent of Roads has made a study of the use being made of a portion of County Road No. 212, the portion proposed to be vacated being described as follows:

"Beginning at a point 1287.0 feet East and 33.0 feet North of the center of section Seven (7), Township Twelve (12) North, Range Twelve (12) East, Cass County, Nebraska, thence North 2607.00 feet, thence N. 68 degrees, E. 574.2 feet, thence N. 68 degrees E. 581.46 feet, to the station house in Cedar Creek, thence 90 degrees right 66.0 feet, thence S 66 degrees W. 579.16 feet, thence South 88 degrees W. 505.32 feet, thence South 1215.82 feet, thence 90 degrees right 66.0 feet, to the place of beginning containing 4.59 acres more or less."

WHEREAS said County Superintendent of Roads has on May 17, 1960, filed in writing to this Board a report upon the study made and his recommendation that said road be vacated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a public hearing be held upon the vacation of said above described road at the office of the Cass County Commissioners in the Court House at Plattsmouth, Nebraska on the 7 day of June, 1960, at 2:00 p.m.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be published once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Plattsmouth Journal and copies of this resolution shall be served by certified mail upon the owners of land abutting on said road not less than two weeks in advance of the hearing.
