Monday brought biggest Western feeder cattle and calf run yet this season at the Omaha market—a 16,500 head count—but demand was more than adequate. Prices were steady to 50c higher, the advance mainly on calves. The calf run alone totalled 4,000.

Yearling stock and feeder steers opened the week at Omaha in a range of \$22.25 to \$26, one drove 538-pound Wyoming \$28.50. Wyoming as heavy as 720 scored \$26. Stock and feeding heifers were bracketed at \$21 to \$23, Wyoming as heavy as 688 included at \$22-50. Steer calves in loadlots sold from \$24.50 to \$31, a few calves for clubwork at \$33. The loadlot pacesetters at \$31 were Nebraska calves weighing 415. Heifer calves cashed at \$24 to \$29, top figure for 326-pound Wyoming.

Meanwhile, better slaughter steers and yearlings sold from \$24 to \$25.25, latter for weights from 1130 to 1367; a part load 1155-pounders \$25.50; bulk \$22-50-\$23.75, plainer cattle \$22 down. Fed heifers ranged from \$21.50 to \$23.75, a part load \$24, lesser quality and finish \$21 down.
