During the evening, the camp was visited by Mrs. Russell Nielsen and Mrs. Bill Spradlin.

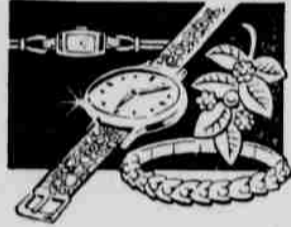

## Donald Thurston Hurt by Blast Of Dynamite

EAGLE (Spec.) — Donald Thurston, 27, of Ottumwa, Iowa, brother of Al Thurston of Eagle is reported to be in good condition at a Lincoln hospital, where he was taken and treated for injuries suffered in a dynamiting accident Sunday.

He was blowing out tree stumps at Hillcrest Golf course when the accident occurred. It caused severe and painful face injuries and necessitated surgery.

He was standing directly over the dynamite when it exploded. He was about to relight the fuse, thinking his first attempt was unsuccessful.

The bandage was removed from one of his eyes Wednesday, and the eyesight is satisfactory. He hoped to be released from the hospital the last of this week. His brother and family from Kansas planned to come to Lincoln to visit him.

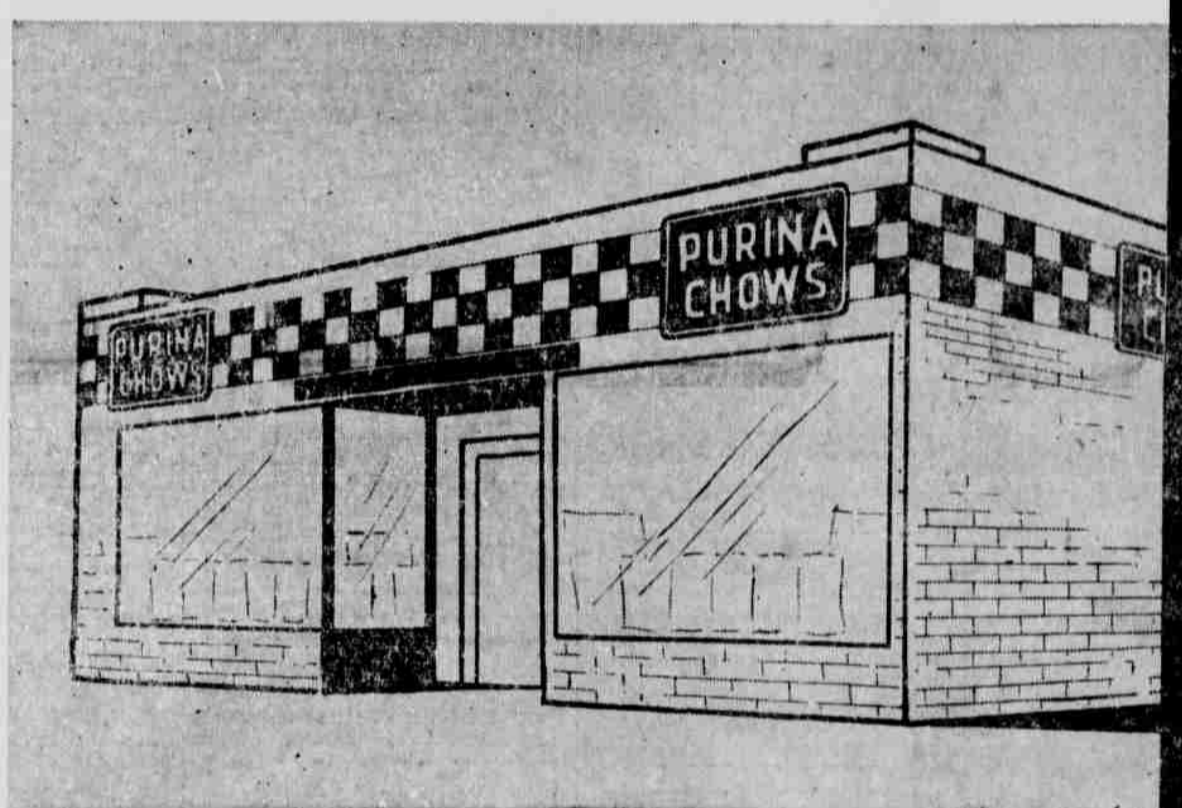
