Methodist—The Senior Choir sang and their special was "The Palms." Children's Union Easter services will be held at this church at 2 p.m. on Good Friday.

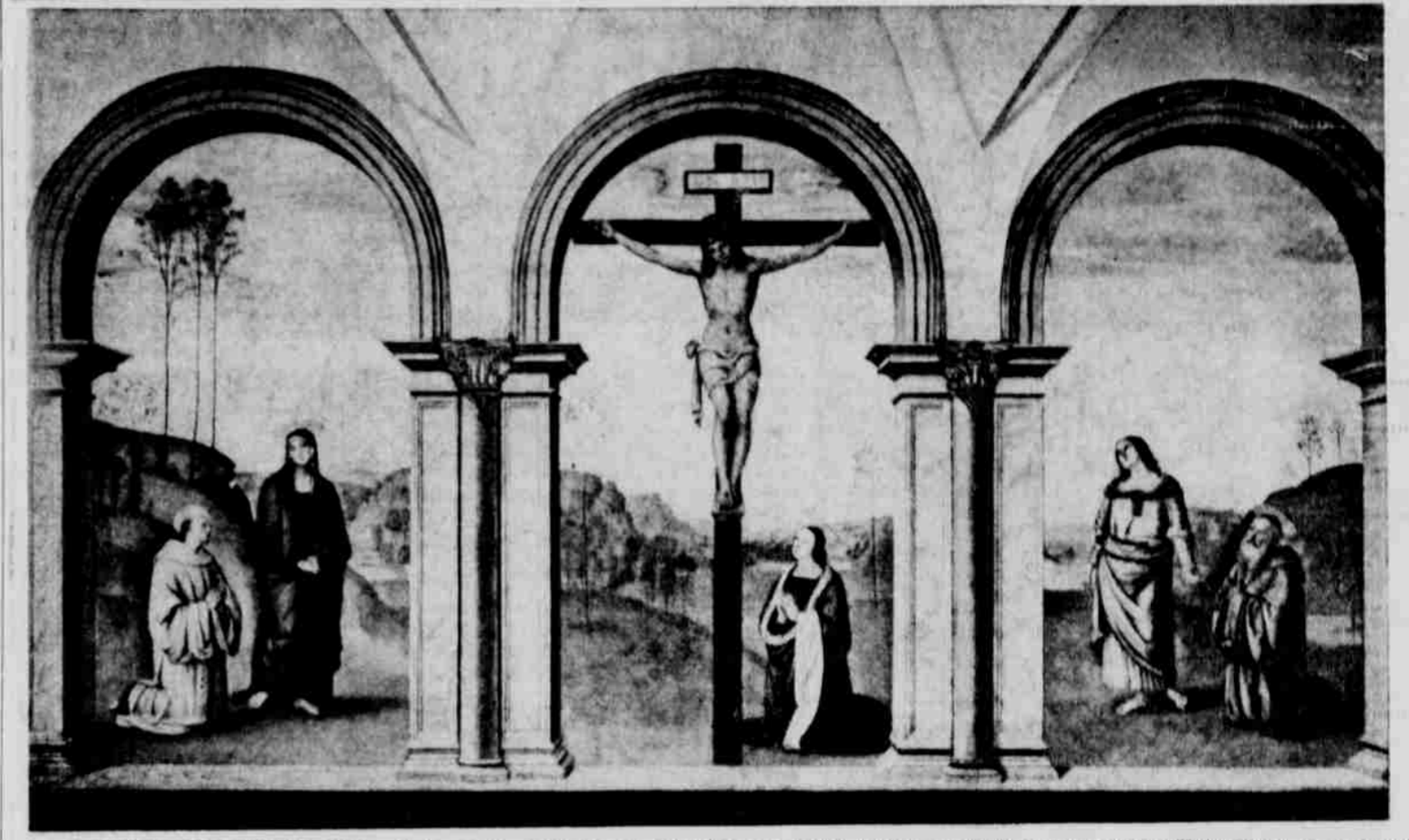
