Motion was made by Todd and seconded by Gregg to hire Fred A. Clark as Superintendent of Roads for one year, effective July 1st, 1961 thru June 30th, 1962 at the same salary, with provisions that either party give thirty days notice before termination of employment. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Bornemeier and seconded by Gregg that the County Board authorize the County Highway Superintendent to install telephones in the County shops at Manley and Elmwood. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Bornemeier and seconded by Gregg that the County Clerk be appointed the Budget Making Authority, and that the County Clerk shall prepare a County Budget document on forms provided by the State of Nebraska (Sec. 23-904 23-905) for the period from July 1st 1961 to June 30th, 1962. Motion carried.
