Mental illness is not a single disease. It takes many forms, including the psychoses, or insanities as they are sometimes called, the neuroses, and personality disorders which manifest themselves in various ways.

Mental illnesses may be due to organic damages, or they may be the result of severe and prolonged stress and strain or a combination of the two. Both physiological and environmental factors are thought to be contributing causes, and of course some people are much more susceptible than others because of physiological conditions which are not yet understood.

Studies have shown that un-
